NEW YORK

Bear Mountain/Harriman State Parks (Orange and Rockland Counties)

Minnewaska State Park Preserve (Ulster County)

Staten Island Greenbelt (New York City)

Ward Pound Ridge Reservation (Westchester County)

(NOTE: Bow hunting is permitted in season [in some areas of Westchester](#), including Ward Pound Ridge on certain days.)

NEW JERSEY

Campgaw Mountain and Ramapo Valley County Reservations (Bergen County)

Garret Mountain Reservation (Passaic County)

New Jersey Section of Palisades Interstate Park (Bergen County)

South Mountain Reservation (Essex County)**Watchung Reservation** (Union County)

Except for some WMAs there is no hunting on Sundays in state and county parks in New Jersey
